## Disease surveillance and response unit (DSRU) works under the supervision of Director General Animal Health and Extension Services, Livestock and Dairy Development Department Balochistan. It functions include;

- Monthly reporting of the World Organization of Animal Health (WOAH) notifiable diseases by each District Livestock Officer in the province to the DSRU
- Monthly report of the diagnostic test findings by Disease investigation laboratory Quetta to the DSRU
- In case of any disease outbreak, it has been immediately reported to the DSRU and own-wards directions had been generated for prompt response
- In the one health perspective, in-charge DSRU coordinates with the Health Department Balochistan, National Institute of Health Islamabad and other relevant stakeholders for zoonotic disease outbreaks and prompt response for its containment
- DSRU compiles all the data from the respective districts in the form of tables and graphs, and further disseminate to the relevant provincial and federal authorities (Animal Husbandry Commissioner office)

## Below are the diseases reported among livestock in Balochistan including accumulative number of animals affected in the province and further segregated into district-wise animal disease data;

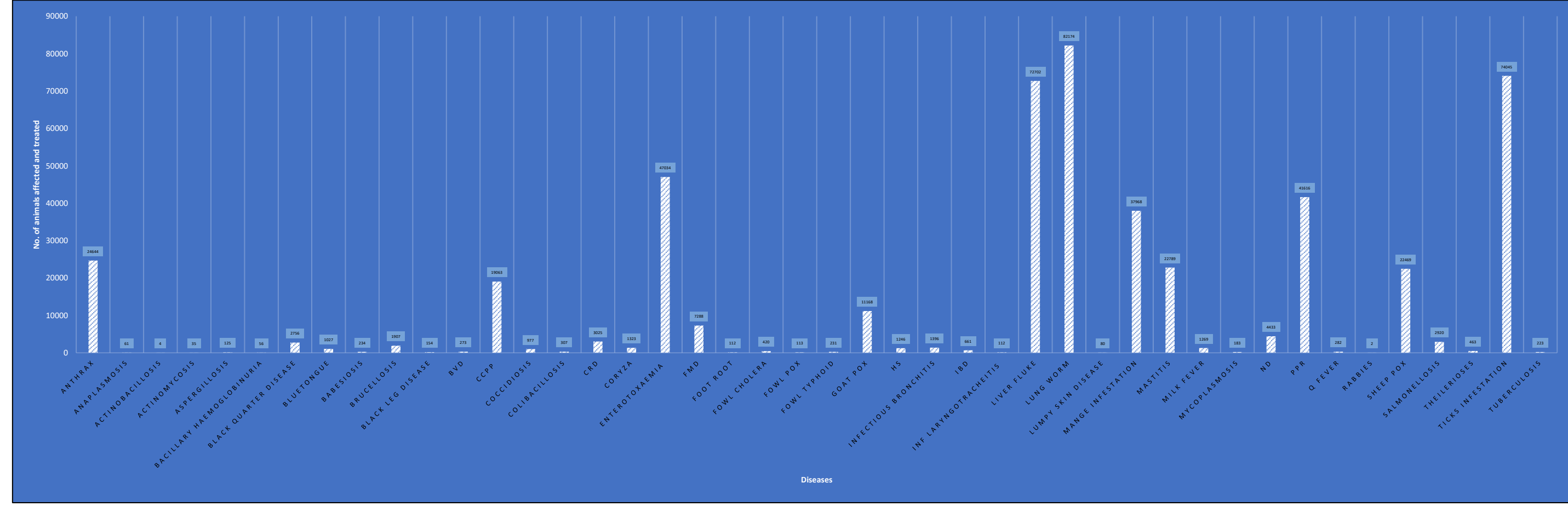


Figure 1. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Balochistan

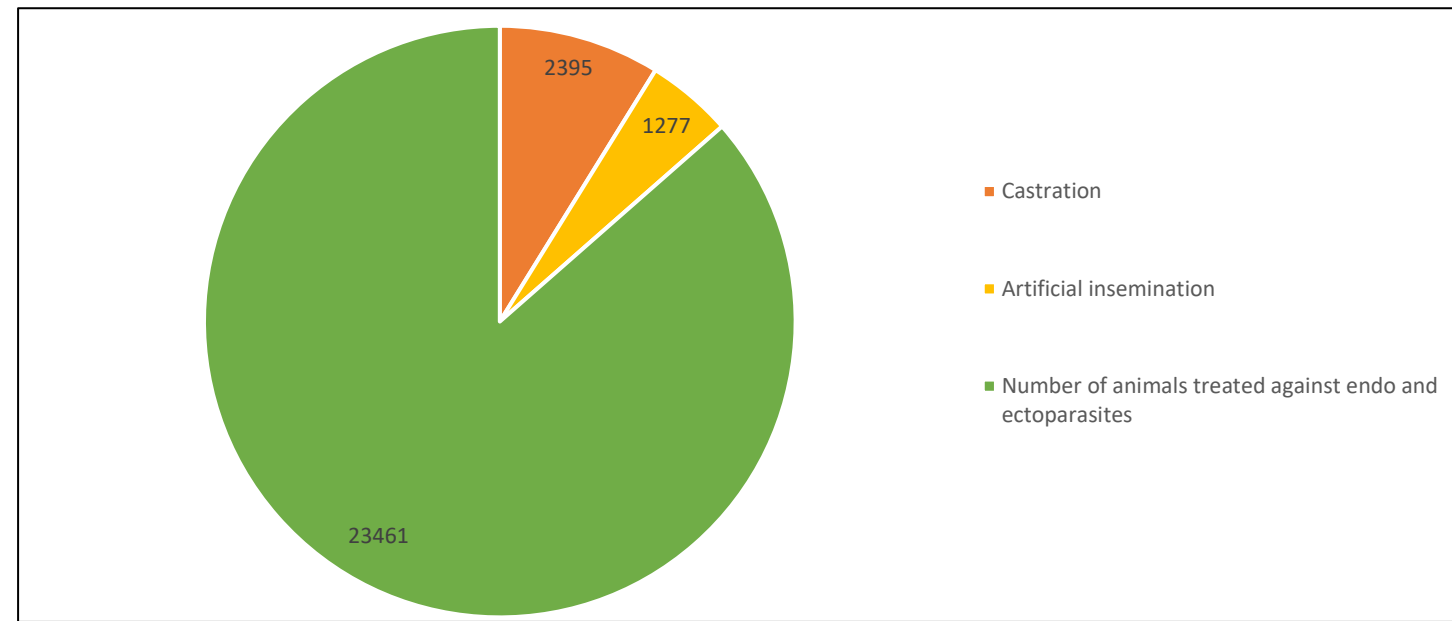


Figure 2. Number of animals castrated, artificial insemination and treatment against endo and ectoparasites in December 2024 in Balochistan

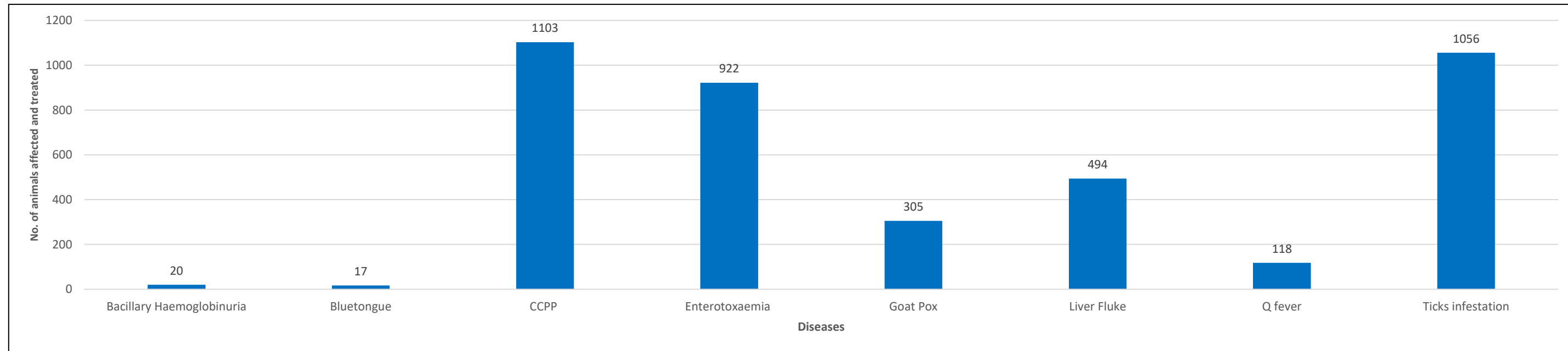


Figure 3. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Awaran district

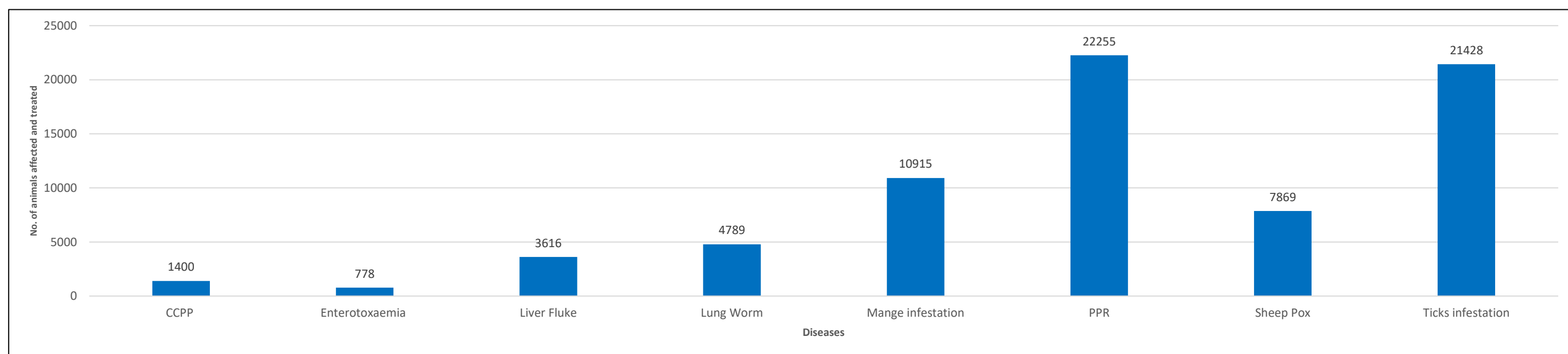


Figure 4. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Barkhan district

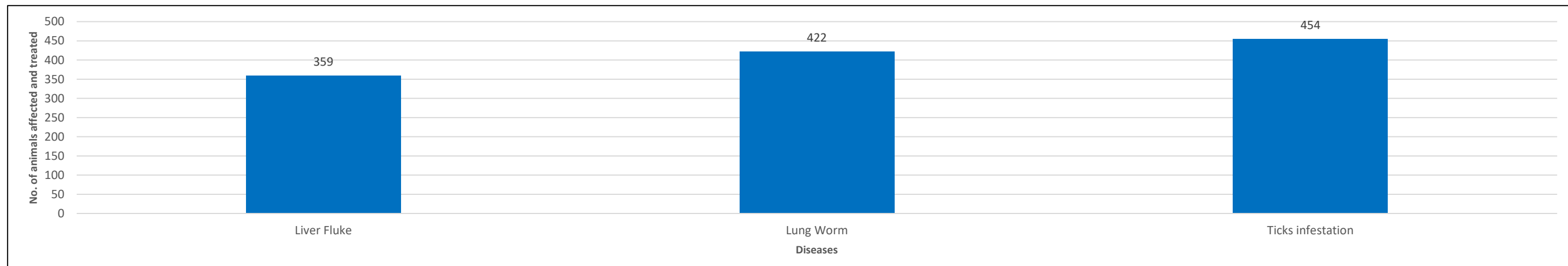


Figure 5. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Chagai district

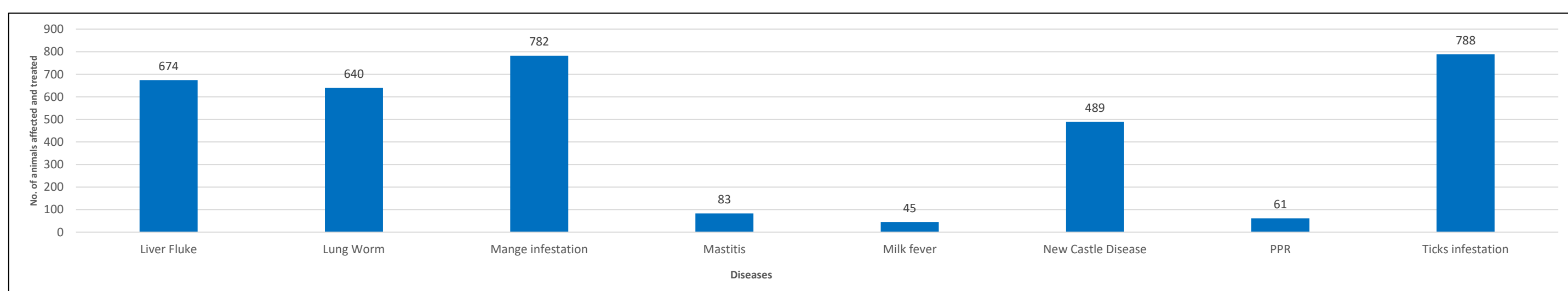


Figure 6. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Chaman district

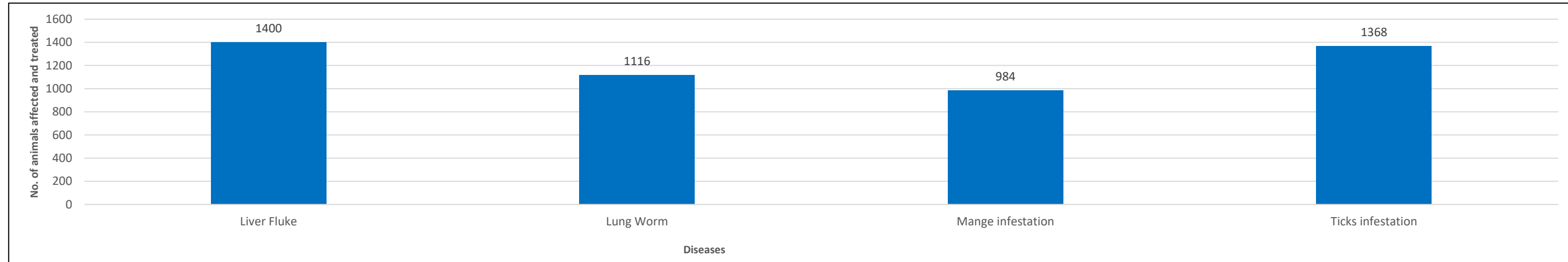


Figure 7. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Duki district

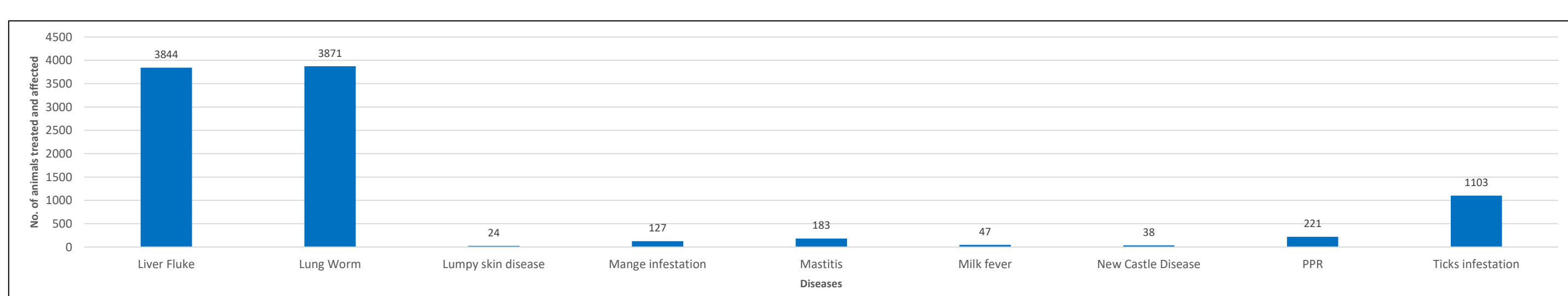


Figure 8. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Gwadar district

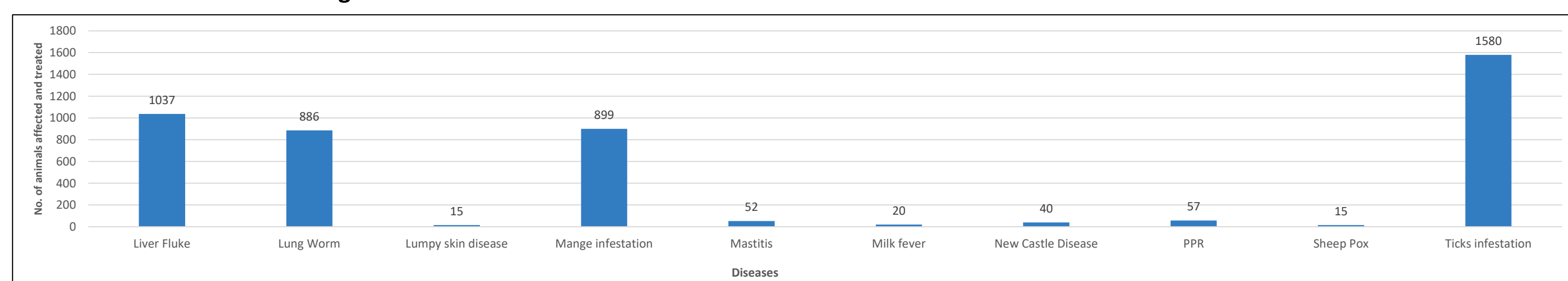


Figure 9. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Harnai district

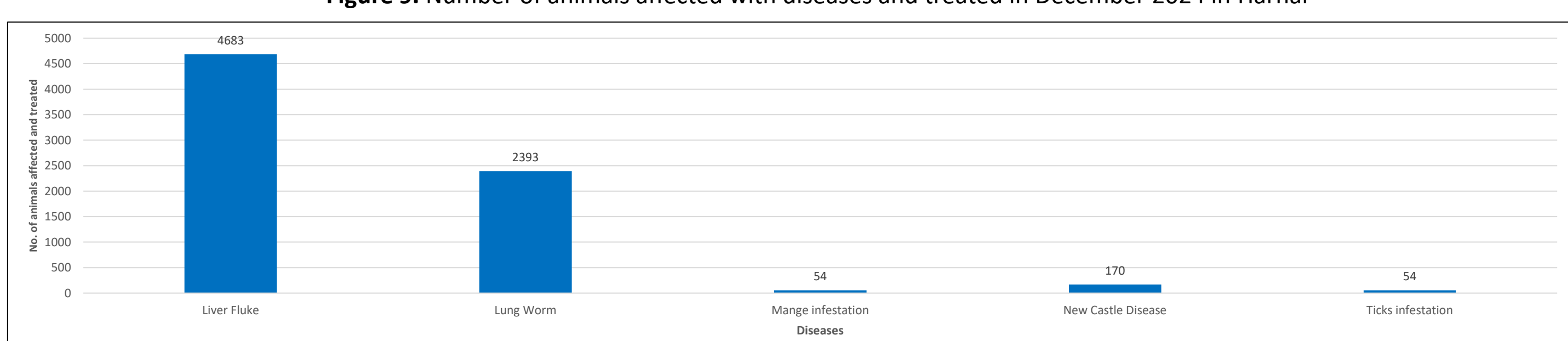


Figure 10. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Jaffarabad district

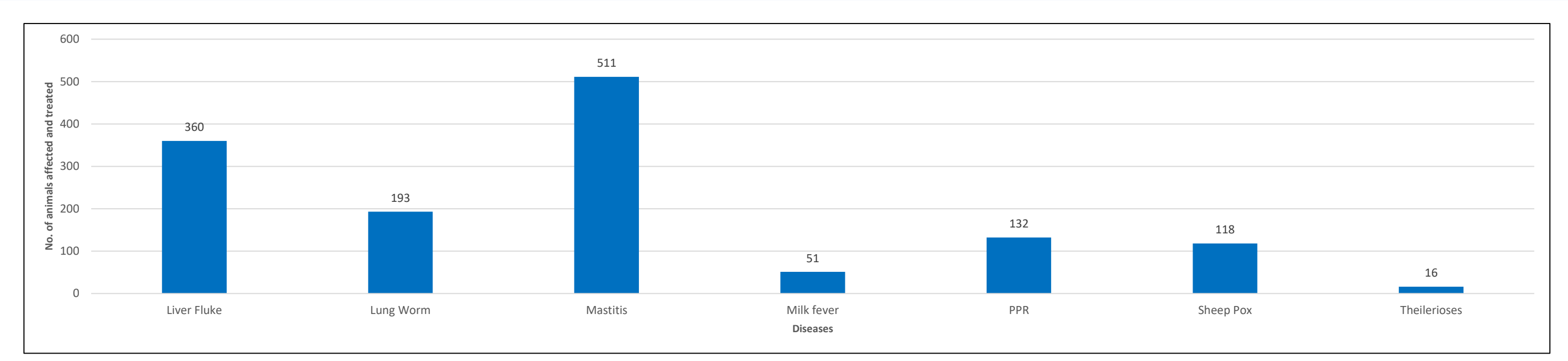


Figure 11. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Jhal Magsi district

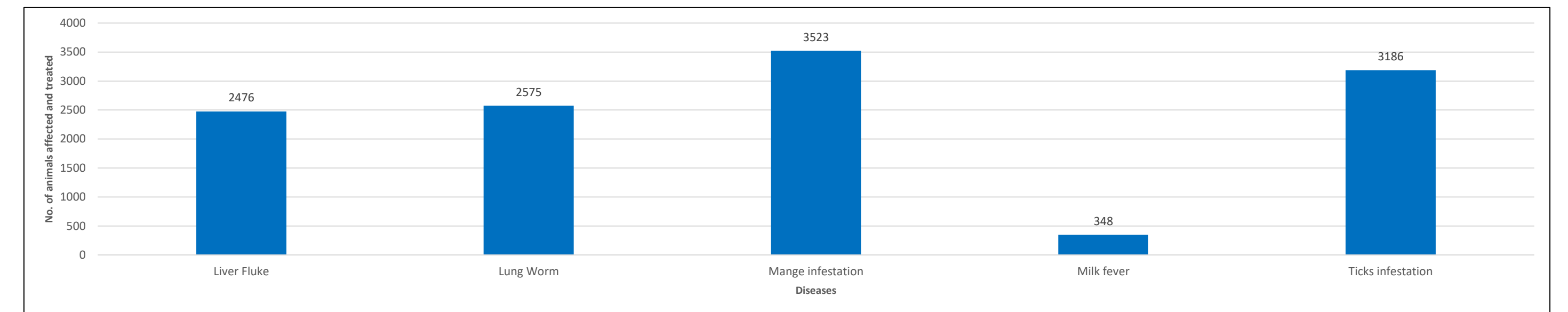


Figure 12. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Kachi district

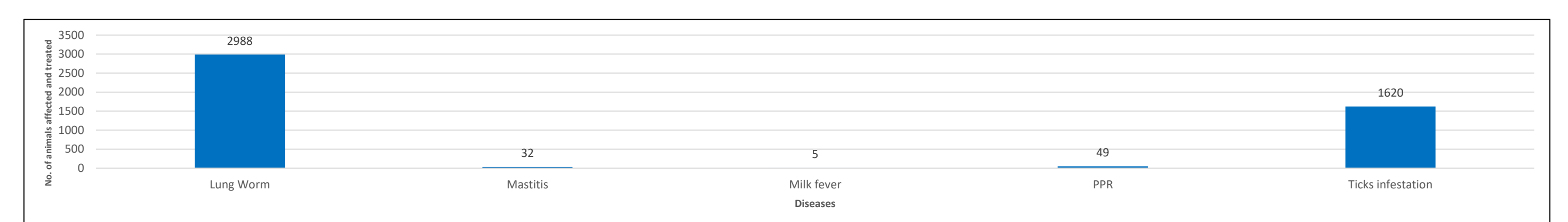


Figure 13. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Kalat district

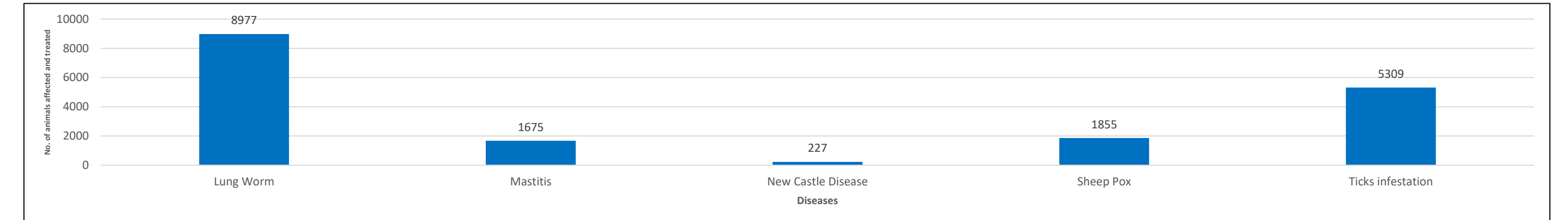


Figure 14. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Kech district

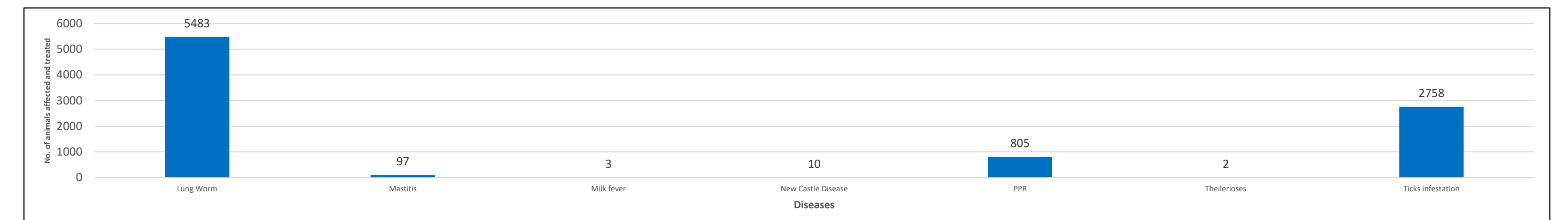


Figure 15. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Khuzdar district

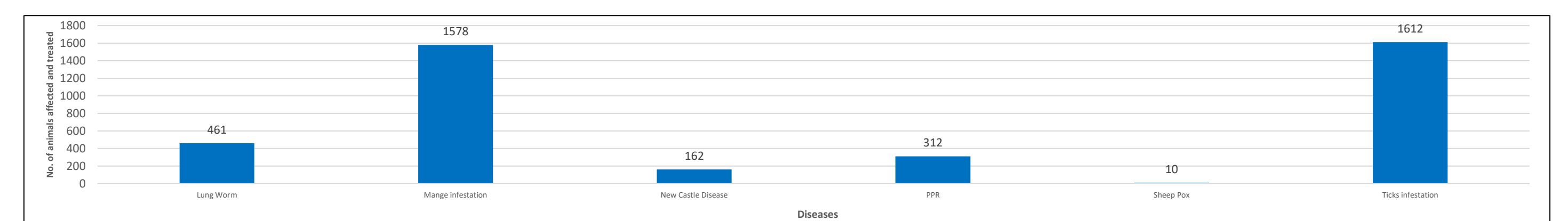


Figure 16. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Killa Abdullah district

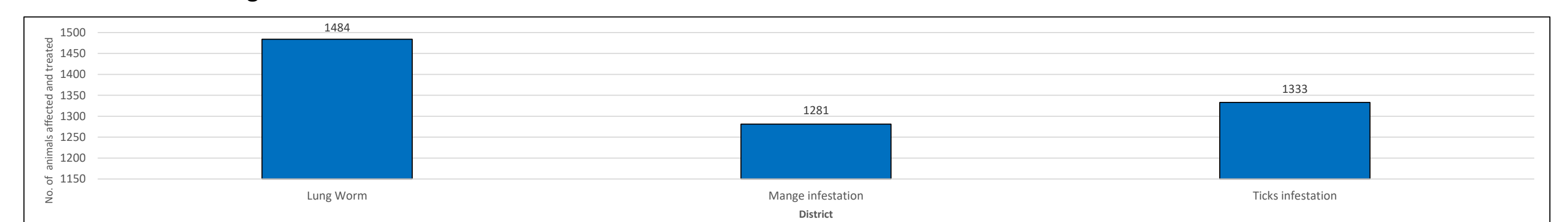


Figure 17. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Killa Saifullah district

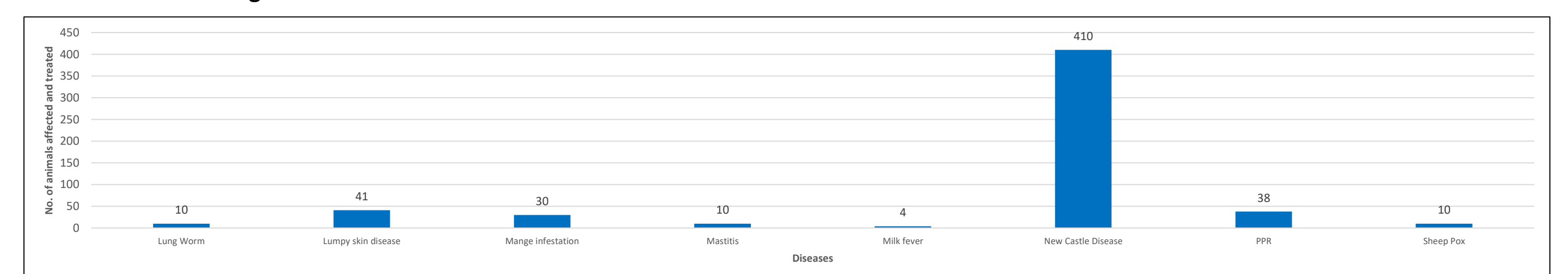


Figure 18. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Kohlu district

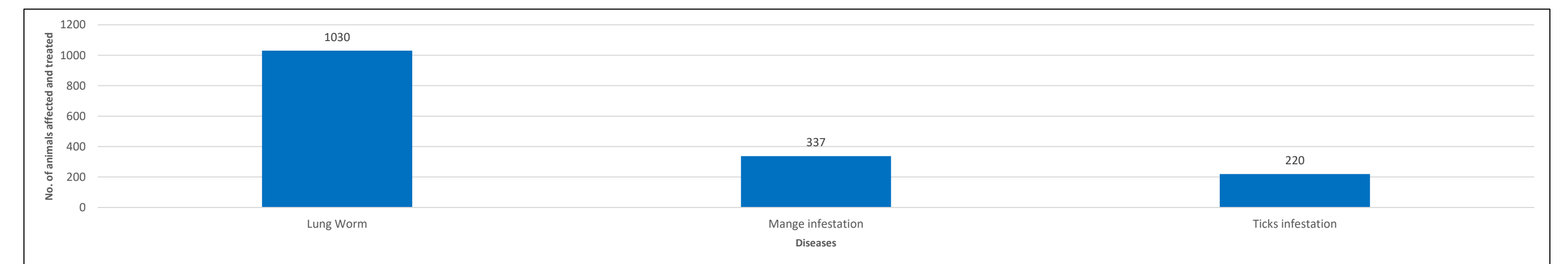


Figure 19. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Lasbela district

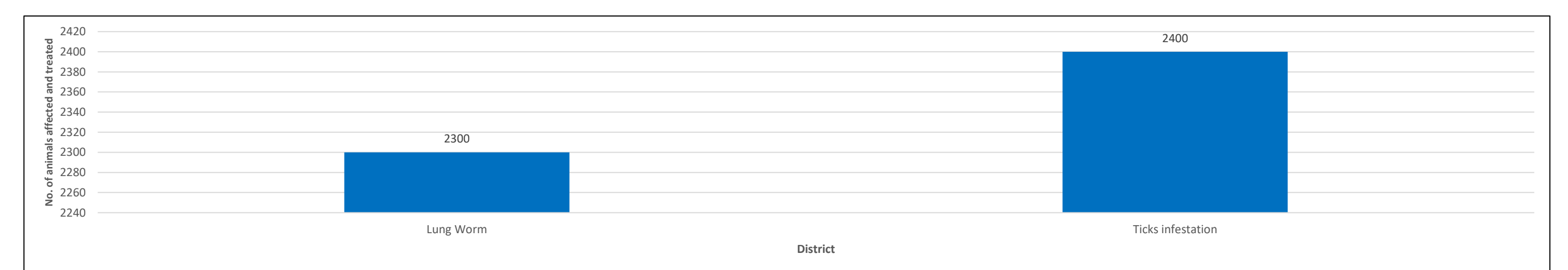


Figure 20. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Loralai district

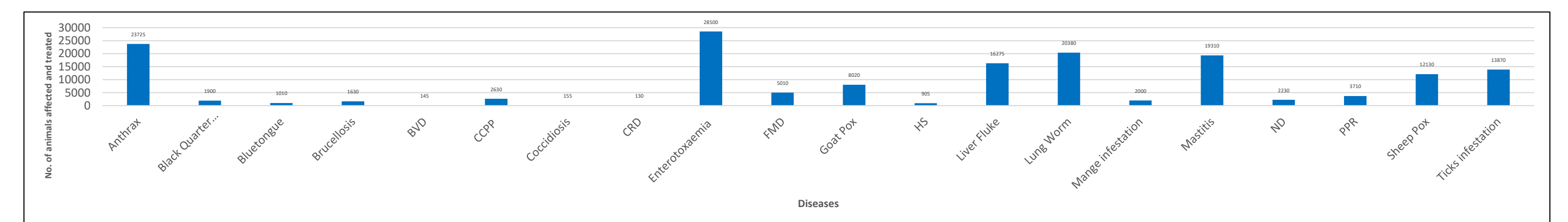


Figure 21. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Musakhail district

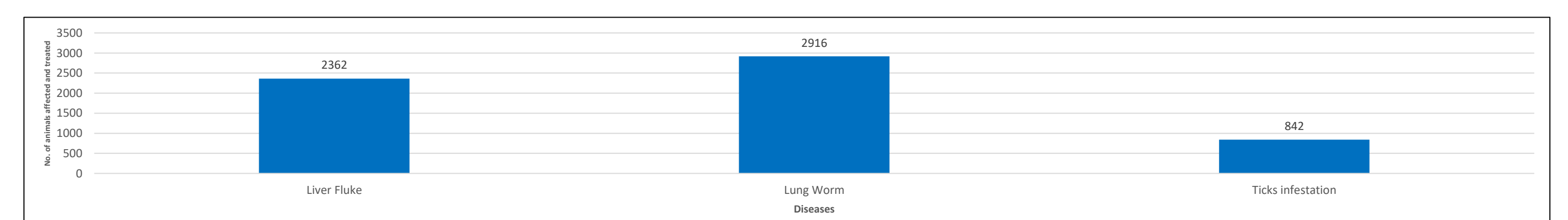


Figure 22. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Mustang district

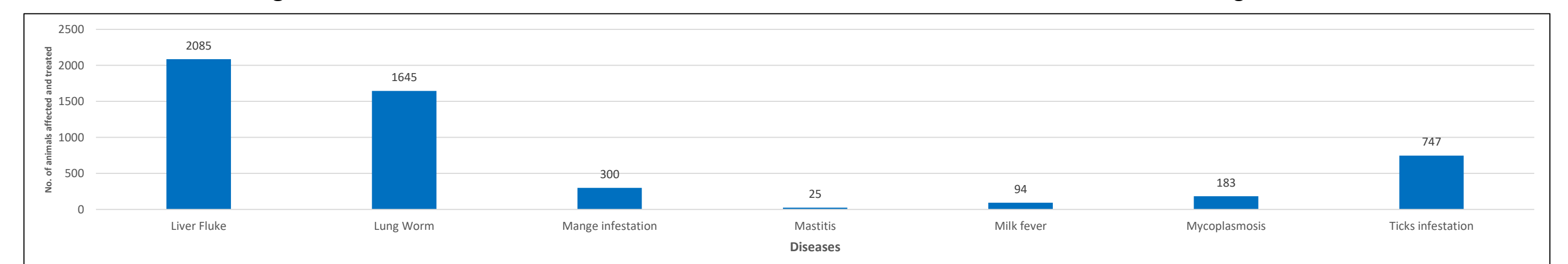


Figure 23. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Nasirabad district

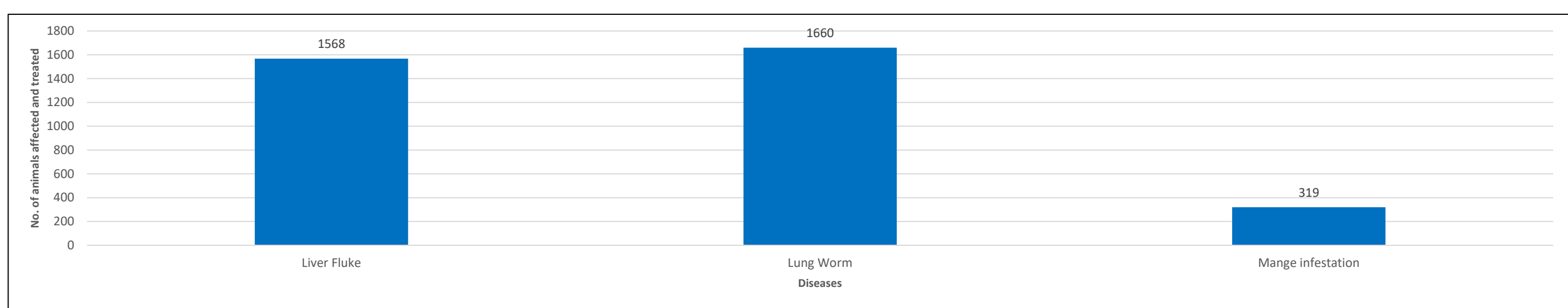


Figure 25. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Pishin district

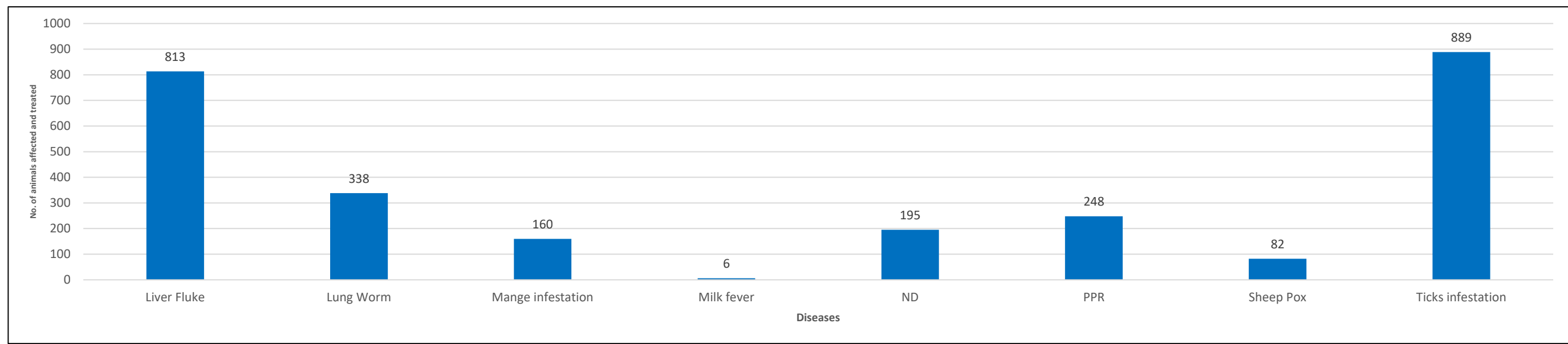


Figure 26. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Punjgur district

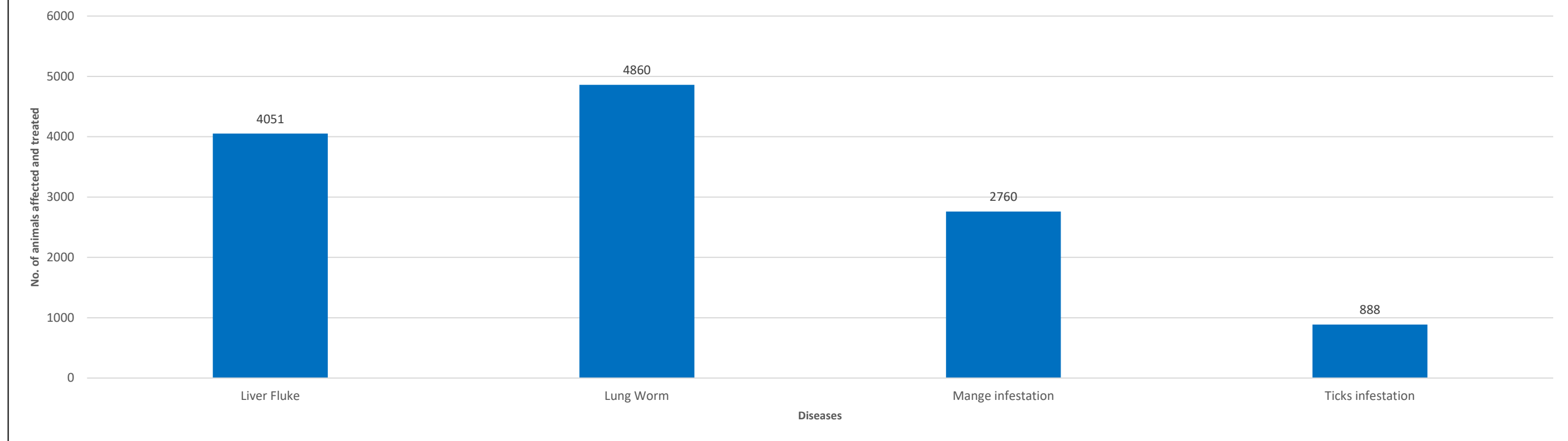


Figure 27. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Quetta district

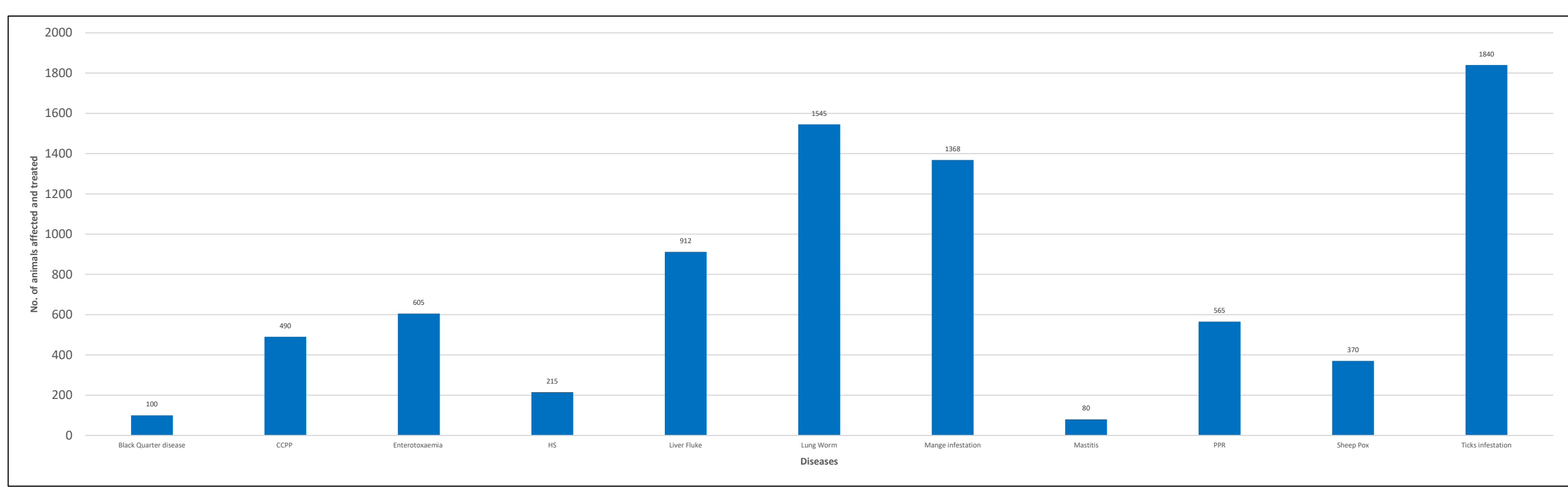


Figure 28. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Sherani district

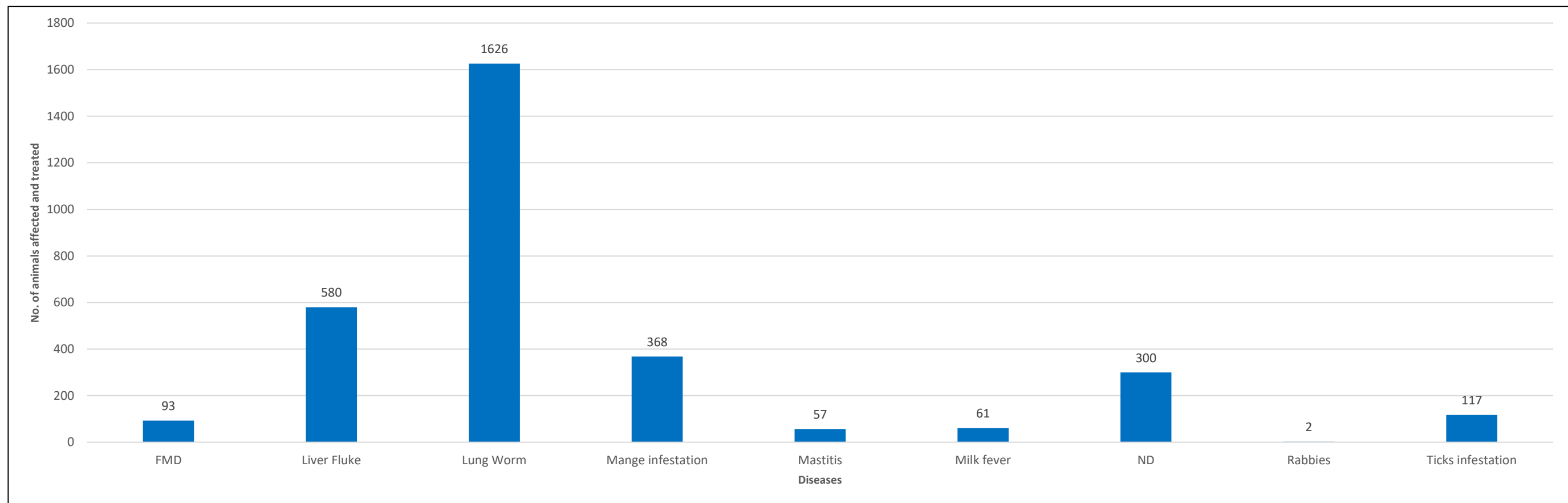


Figure 29. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Sibi district

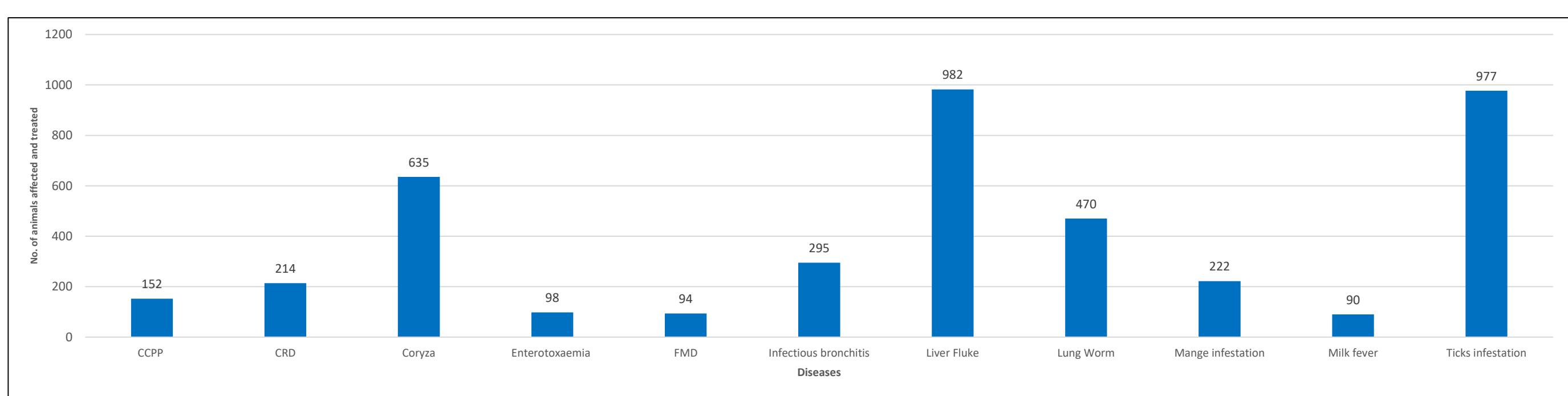


Figure 30. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Sohatpur district

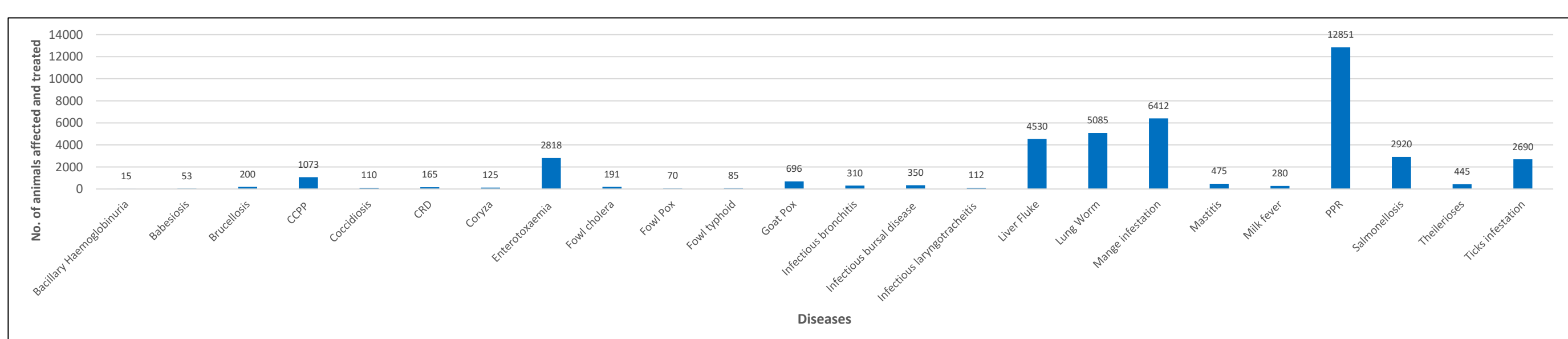


Figure 31. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Surab district

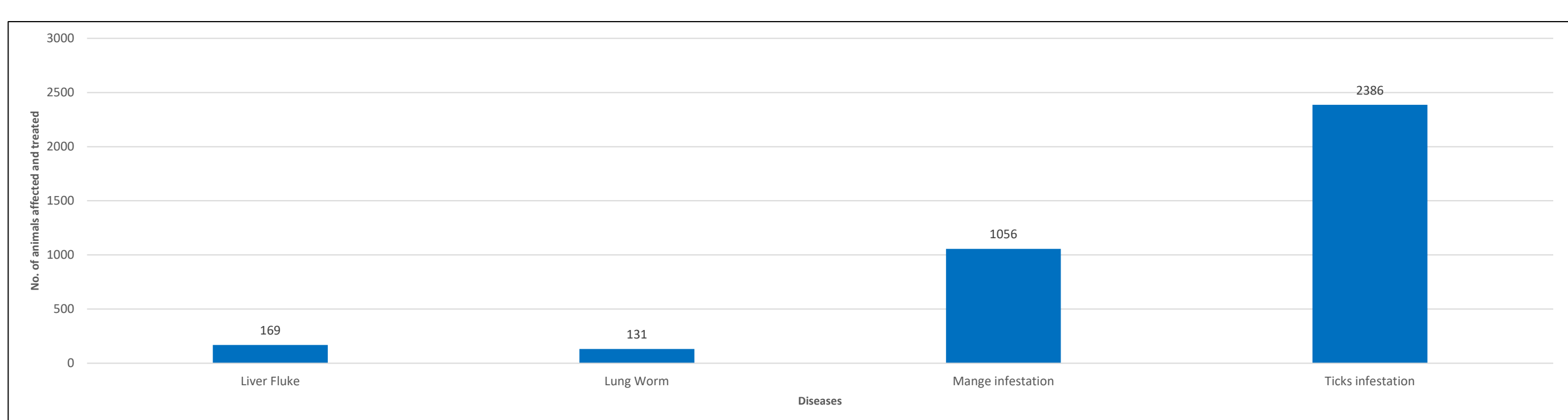


Figure 32. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Washuk district

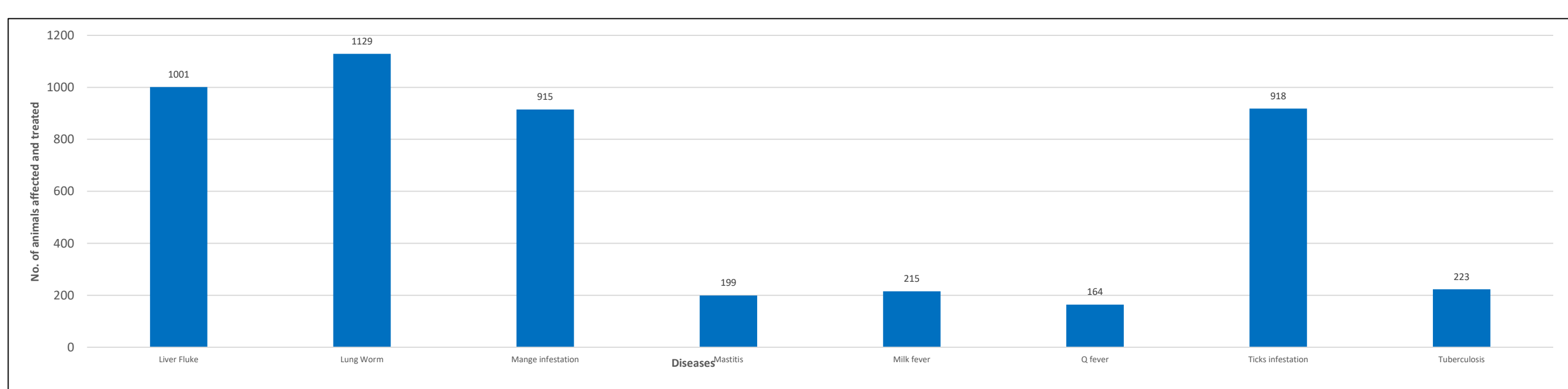


Figure 33. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Zhob district

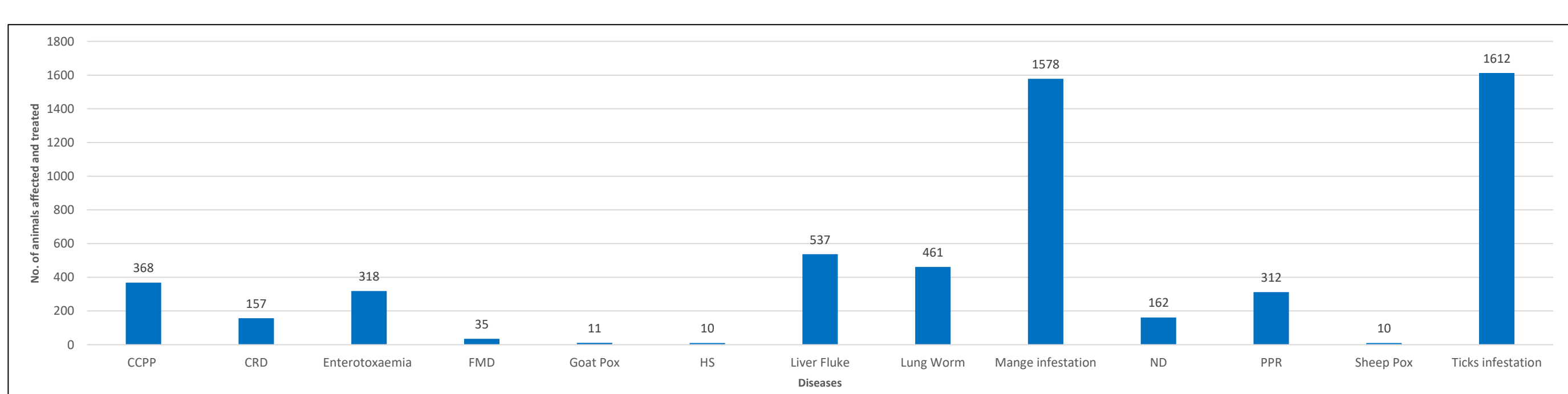


Figure 34. Number of animals affected with diseases and treated in December 2024 in Ziarat district
